

# HSS Board **Communiqué** February 2022 Meeting

# **Key Discussion**

The Board held a wide-ranging discussion regarding various topics across all HSS Business Units. These included:

- HSS' ongoing response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including the support being provided to customers and employees through these uncertain times.
- The achievement of 91% of HSS' Service Level Agreement (SLA) KPIs in the month of December 2021 against a target of 80% (HSS' highest SLA performance to date).
- Progress with HSS' major programs, including the Medical Imaging Replacement Program (MIRP) and work underway to refresh network infrastructure across the state.
- A deep dive into one of HSS' strategic risks related to financial management.

# **Chief Executive's Update**

The Chief Executive provided an update on the key achievements and issues across HSS in December 2021 and January 2022. These included:

- An update on HSS COVID-19 response activities, including the supply and distribution of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs), employee wellness support activities and booster vaccination rates.
- Successfully securing funding for Phase 2 of the Human Resource Management Information System (HRMIS) program through the mid-year review budget process, and subsequently executing the associated contracts to commence implementation and delivery.
- Successfully launching the new HSS Strategic Plan 2022-24 and progress with the development of the associated Implementation Plan.

## **Key Decisions**

The HSS Board approved:

- The approach and format of the Board Committee Self-Assessment process to commence in February 2022.
- The Quarterly Report (October-December 2021) to the Minister for Health on HSS progress against the Statement of Intent.
- Updates to the HSS Board Governance Manual, HSS Board Communications Protocol, HSS Board Code of Conduct following their scheduled review.
- Minor changes to the HSS Legal and Policy Authorisations Schedules.
